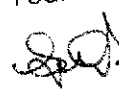
Subject: Information sought under the RTI Act, 2005.

Sir,
Please refer to your RTI request bearing Registration No. DOHRE/R/E/25/00080 dated 17.04.2025, seeking information under RTI Act, 2005. In this regard, it is pertinent to mention that as per observations of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No. 6454 of 2011 and as per guidelines in DoPT's O.M. No. 1/69/2007-IR, dated 27th February, 2008, (para 8); only such information can be supplied under the Act which already exists and is held by the public authority. The CPIO is not supposed to create information; or to interpret information; or to solve the problems raised by the applicants; or to furnish replies to hypothetical questions. Further, the interrogative queries are not under the ambit of RTI, Act 2005. However, the information/reply of your queries is as under:

2. The matter of recognition of Eletrography/ Electrohomoeopathy as a system of medicine is still under consideration by the Inter-Departmental Committee (IDC). A joint body of electrohomoeopathy organisations is interacting with the Inter-Departmental Committee. IDC keeps discussing this matter with its officials and members from time to time and no conclusion has been reached yet, but IDC is working on the matter. Therefore, it needs to be appreciated that the Committee can submit its final report only after the process of its through examination of the matter is over.

3. If you are not satisfied with the above reply, you may prefer an appeal to First Appellate Authority Shri B. Senapati, Director, Department of Health Research, Room No 207, 2nd floor, IRCS building, Red Cross road, New Delhi.
